Our major fund raising event at the Peridot theatre is fast approaching. Have you made your last minute sales push to help fill the theatre? Thank you all who have contributed so far.

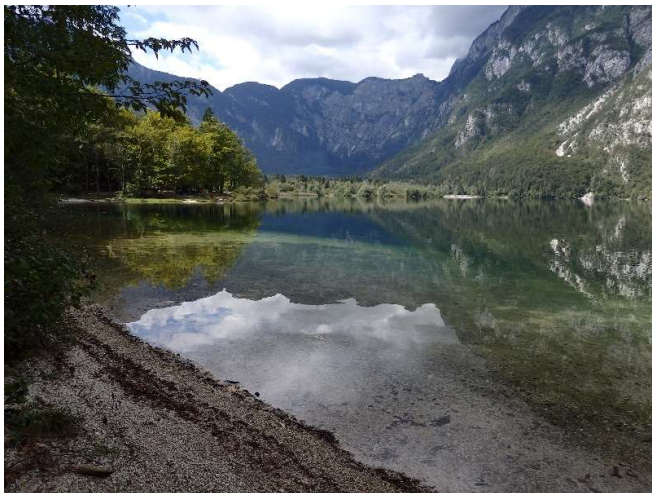

Our market is receiving strong advertising support from the rail crossing authority, and they are also providing entertainment and children's activities in supporting this community event.

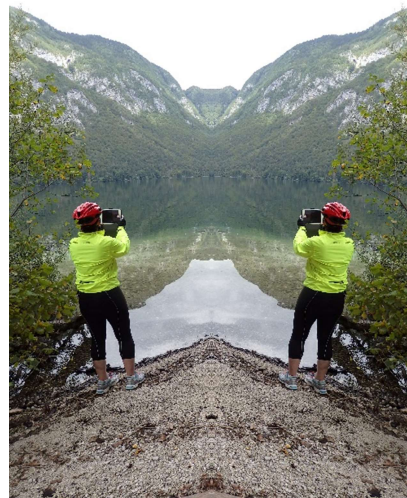

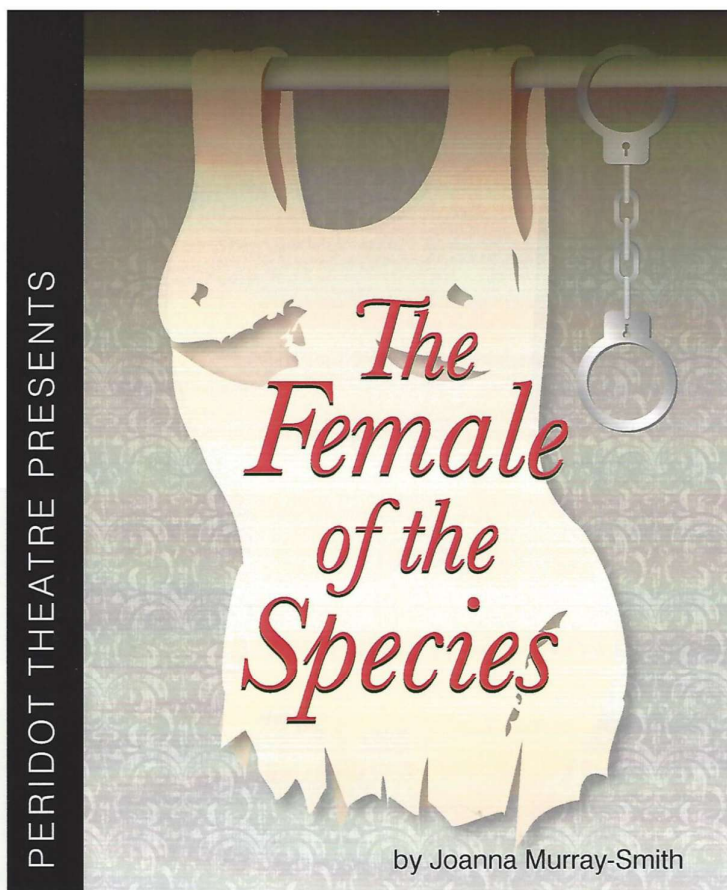
### **I'll be asking for some assistance to make sure the night goes smoothly, and the catering is sufficient**
