Ron introduced Blaise. She runs a publishing company with her husband-Busybird Publishing. Blaise walked the Camino on her 50th birthday on her own in 2018. She did the traditional walk of 799 km. Legend has it that some apostles carried the body of Saint James to Santiago de Compostela.... The end of the earth. On the walk she met a diverse collection of walkers – aged 16 to 82 years and from many, many countries. She took 41 days to do the walk and stayed in 40 different pilgrim accommodation places. Accommodation was quite cheap – sometimes just a donation, but there were times when she paid 12 Euros per night. One night she was in a church with 50 people. Blaise averaged paying AUD \$50.00 per day for food, and accommodation. A very cheap holiday. The scallop shell is the symbol of the Camino... Blaise found the Camino (which means –the way) a metaphor for life.. many trials, many ups and downs. She believed that on the walk she would learn about herself. Her conclusion –"She already knew what she had to know." An interesting and insightful talk.



The raffle raised \$47. Blaise contributed a book to the raffle prizes. Winners were Sue, Blaise and Bob Laslett. Stuart thanked Blaise and presented her with a pen. Meeting closed close to 8 pm.
