

A well- attended meeting listened to Linda Hammond describing how she has been a passionate person wanting to assist young people having problems. After joining the Good Shepherd organization she was in the position to fulfil her aim of working individually with children from dysfunctional families. She considers it important to look for the reasons behind children's behaviour and assist them non-judgementally. At times it has been necessary to attend school with clients. This has led to the establishment of a type of school to assist children who, because of their behaviour, have been excluded from normal schools. At times this has come to groups learning to do normal cooking activities which they have not seen before. Some of the students need to be given good nutrition to overcome health problems. As it is difficult for these children to concentrate for long periods leniency has to be shown in behaviour standards. Linda values the success stories and considers the very difficult task is very satisfying.
